## **Terms and Conditions**

#### 1. Payment of Fees

All students must have paid in full at least 15 days before arrival. Tuition, accommodation and/or airport transfer details will not be confirmed until all fees have been paid in full.

#### 2. Insurance

Every student must have appropriate medical insurance. IHB recommends using Global Guard Insurance (www.guard.me) and offers their insurance for \$2/day, minimum of 2 weeks. Students not wishing to take Global Guard Insurance must present an insurance certificate on arrival.

## 3. Registration Fee and Accommodation Arrangement Fee

The \$100 Registration Fee and the Accommodation Arrangement Fee are non-refundable.

#### 4. Cancellation and Refund Policy

4.1 All cancellation requests must be received in writing. 4.2 For cancellation requests received before the first day of class, or for students who never attend their course (no show), students will be charged only the non-refundable registration and accommodation arrangement fees, plus the fees related to any services (such as couriers or insurance) that have already been provided by that date, the sum of which is not to exceed \$500. In addition, student may be liable for fees connected with accommodation cancellation (see section 5 for accommodation cancellation and refund information).

4.3 From the first day of class, no refunds will apply to courses of 4 weeks or less.

4.4 For courses longer than 4 weeks, students who terminate their course within the first four weeks will be entitled to a refund of all tuition fees except for those relating to the first 4 weeks.4.5 For courses longer than 4 weeks, students who terminate their course after 4 weeks but before or at the mid-point of their course will be entitled to a pro-rated amount of tuition.

4.6 No refunds apply for courses cancelled after the mid-point.4.7 Refunds are calculated from the end of the last week the student attended classes at the non-discounted rate.

4.8 Pro-rated refunds will be calculated on a weekly basis. IHB considers a partial week to be the same as a whole week.4.9 IHB will make all refunds within 28 days of receipt of both written refund request and the bank account or card details needed to be able to process the refund. IHB will only refund the person or agency that made the initial payment.

4.10 An administration fee of \$100 will be applied to any course changes made after the first day of class.
