
The International House World Organization (IHWO) is a worldwide network of language schools that is committed to implementing high standards of quality and innovation in education and training.

In addition to having the best-qualified and most professional language teachers around, we are also proud of our state-of-the-art schools in the most fashionable, touristic and convenient neighborhoods.






