Airport transfer on arrival: € 35, **Airport transfer on departure:** € 35, **Visa courier fee:** € 80 (only applicable if you need to apply for a visa), **Alteration fee after arrival:** € 30, **Medical insurance:** € 21 application fee and € 21 per calendar month (minimum period: 3 months).

Refundable deposit: ZAR 2.000 / € 150, payable on the first day of school to cover coursebook, key rentals and breakage. Will be refunded on the last day of school.

Course start: General English courses and Private Lessons can start on **any Monday**, although we advise students to start on the recommended starting dates. Beginners and students doing IELTS, TOEFL or English for Work can only start on the recommended starting dates.

Recommended course start dates: 3 Jan, 30 Jan, 27 Feb, 27 Mar, 24 Apr, 22 May, 19 June, 17 July, 14 Aug, 11 Sept, 9 Oct, 6 Nov, 4 Dec.

Cambridge course start dates: 9 weeks: 9 Jan; 10 weeks: 27 Mar, 26 Sept (CAE, CPE), 2 Oct (FCE); CPE candidates starting on 27 Mar require an extra week of accommodation for the exam. Additional costs, payable at the school: R 1.100 (€ 65) for books and ZAR 2.300 (€ 135) exam fees.

CELTA course start dates: 9 Jan, 13 Feb, 27 Mar, 19 June, 7 Aug, 6 Nov.

Public holidays: 2 Jan, 21 Mar, 14, 17, 27 Apr, 1 May, 16 June, 9 Aug, 25 Sept, 16, 25 and 26 Dec, 1 Jan 2018. Where Monday is a public holiday courses start on a Tuesday. Only private lessons missed due to public holidays will be made up at other times. Any other lessons will not be made up.

How to enrol

1. Enrol online or send this form to bookings@ghs.co.za.
2. We will check availability and confirm with you within one working day.
3. You are then required to pay a non-refundable deposit of € 110 / US\$ 140 / ZAR 2.000 to secure your booking.
4. After receiving your deposit, we will send you a confirmation of booking.
5. *If you don't need to apply for a visa in your home country:* pay the outstanding amount not less than 2 weeks prior to arrival.
If you need to apply for a visa in your home country: pay the outstanding amount immediately after receiving the confirmation of booking. We will then send you all documents required for a visa application.

General Conditions

1. Booking

Your registration results in the existence of a contract upon written confirmation from Good Hope Studies.

2. Alteration and Cancellation

An alteration fee will be charged for alteration of bookings.

Notice of cancellation before arrival must be made in writing to Good Hope Studies. The deposit is not refundable. For cancellations received within 2 weeks prior to arrival, the cancellation fee amounts to 1 week's tuition and accommodation.

Should any services be cancelled that are not printed on our price list (hotels, flight-tickets, etc.), the cancellation charges of the third party provider will apply.

Tuition fees will be refunded in full if a visa application is rejected or Good Hope Studies is unable to offer the course or a suitable alternative.

3. Withdrawal

No refund is possible in the event of cancellation after arrival, or of no-show of the participant. No refund is given if the student is asked to leave due to unsatisfactory attendance or performance.

4. Minimum number of participants

All courses require a minimum number of 3 participants. Should the minimum number not be reached, the school reserves the right to offer an alternative course instead or run the course with a reduced number of lessons. Depending on the course, the reduction is between 20% and 33%.

5. Accommodation

When booking accommodation, the student accepts and agrees to the "House Rules". No refund shall be considered for any student who is asked to leave any accommodation belonging to Good Hope Studies for reasons related to a violation of the "House Rules".

6. Insurance

Students are not insured by Good Hope Studies against illness, accident, theft or any loss of personal effects.

Good Hope Studies or its representatives cannot accept responsibility for any accident occurring during the course, on or off the course premises, on excursions or during activities. Personal insurance cover is therefore recommended. Full personal insurance cover should be taken out to include medical and any other expenses and also loss of fees should the whole or part of a course or any activity, paid in advance, not be attended.
