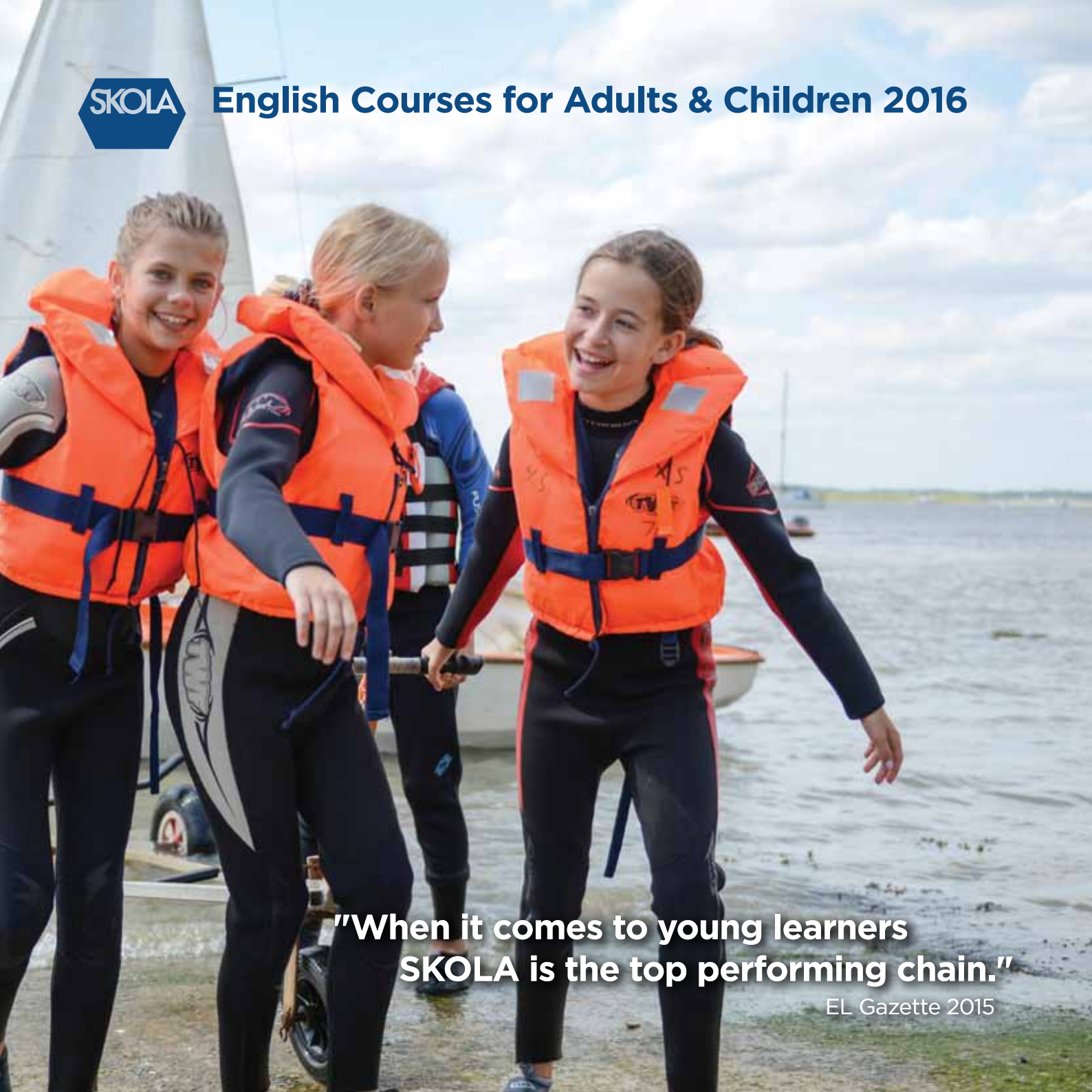




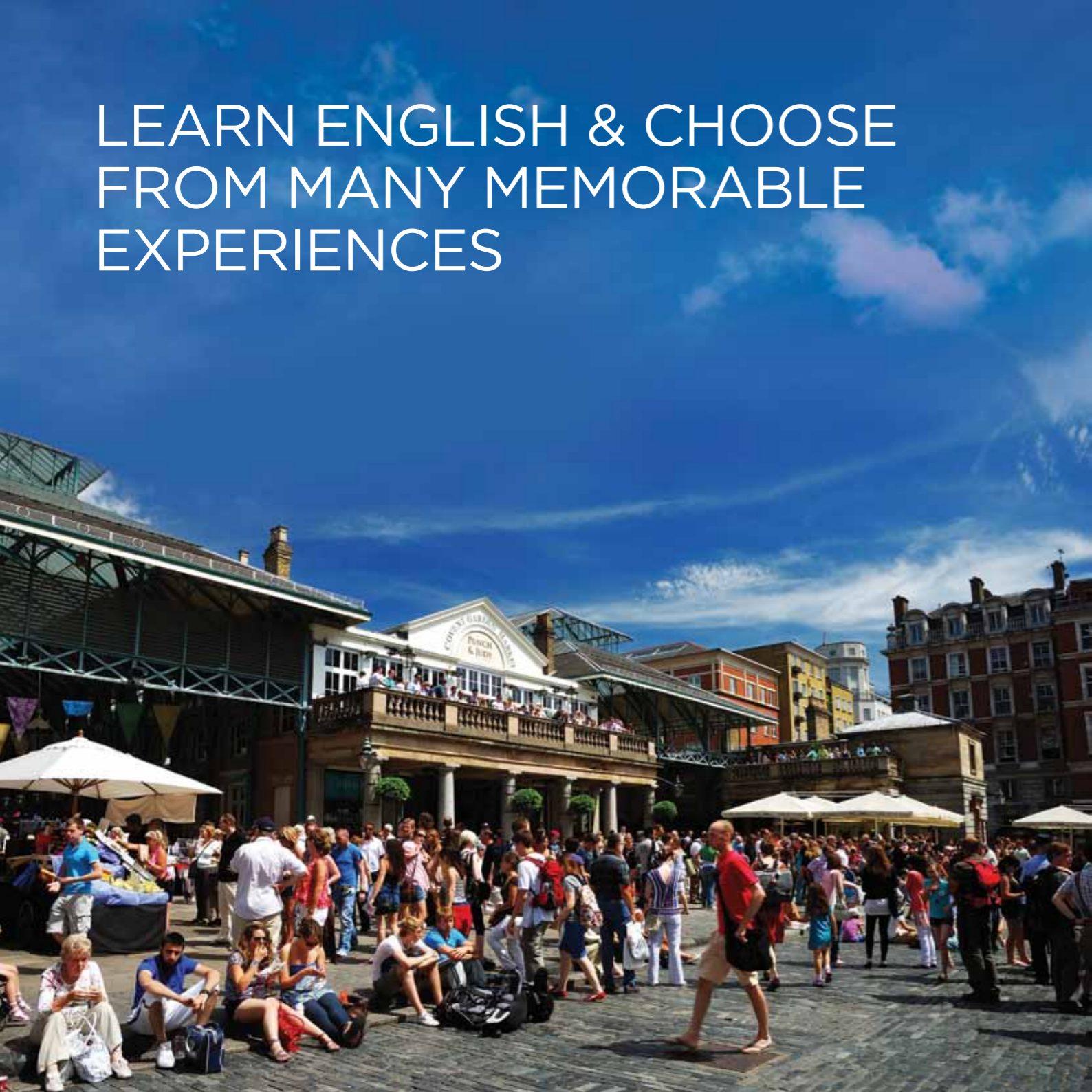

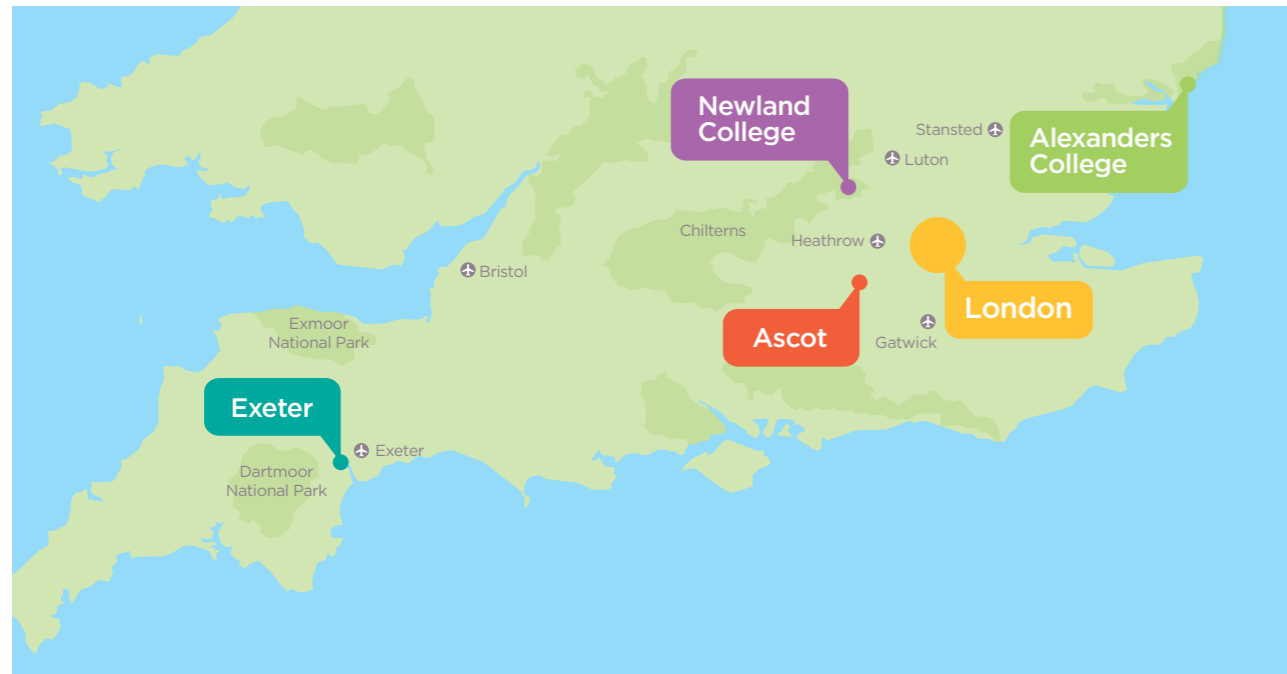

WHERE DO YOU WANT TO BE?



Homestay accommodation

The minimum age for unaccompanied children in homestay is 11 years old. All our homestay hosts are selected by partner accommodation agencies specialised in providing accommodation suitable for children and families. Hosts are British citizens who speak English in the home but are sometimes born abroad. They are chosen only after a strict application process, inspection and safety checks. Travel times in Exeter are around 30 minutes maximum and around 60 minutes in London.

Junior homestay accommodation includes breakfast and evening meal every day and lunch or packed lunch at weekends.

Residential accommodation

All students are accommodated in school residences on campus. Boys and girls are in separate residences or on separate floors. At Alexanders College, students are in rooms with 2, 3 or 4 beds. At Ascot Summer School the rooms contain 2-6 beds and at Newland College there are 1 or 2 beds per room. In Exeter we have single ensuite rooms. Unless requested otherwise by all parents involved, children sharing together will be of different mother tongues where possible. Most bedrooms contain washbasins, but bathroom and toilet facilities are shared. All accommodation provides 3 meals per day.

Homestay accommodation



London

We operate seven adult and junior English language schools in London, centred on three main locations. Our two year-round schools are in Soho (adults) and Camden (children and teenagers), two iconic locations known as off-beat, creative hubs peppered with shops and restaurants. We describe our other schools as being located 'between the parks' as they are all within walking distance of Regent's Park and Hyde Park, spread across another area known for shopping and eating, Marylebone.



Exeter, Devon

Exeter is the capital city of Devon, south west UK, 2 hours from London by train. It's a beautiful and safe historical city. Founded 2,000 years ago, it has a population of 120,000. The city is home to Exeter University, a world top 100 university and Roman, medieval and Tudor buildings and monuments. Exeter is close to beautiful beaches and some of the UK's most beautiful countryside. It is a vibrant and modern English city with something for everyone. See pages 41, 43 & 45.

Alexanders College, Bawdsey, Suffolk

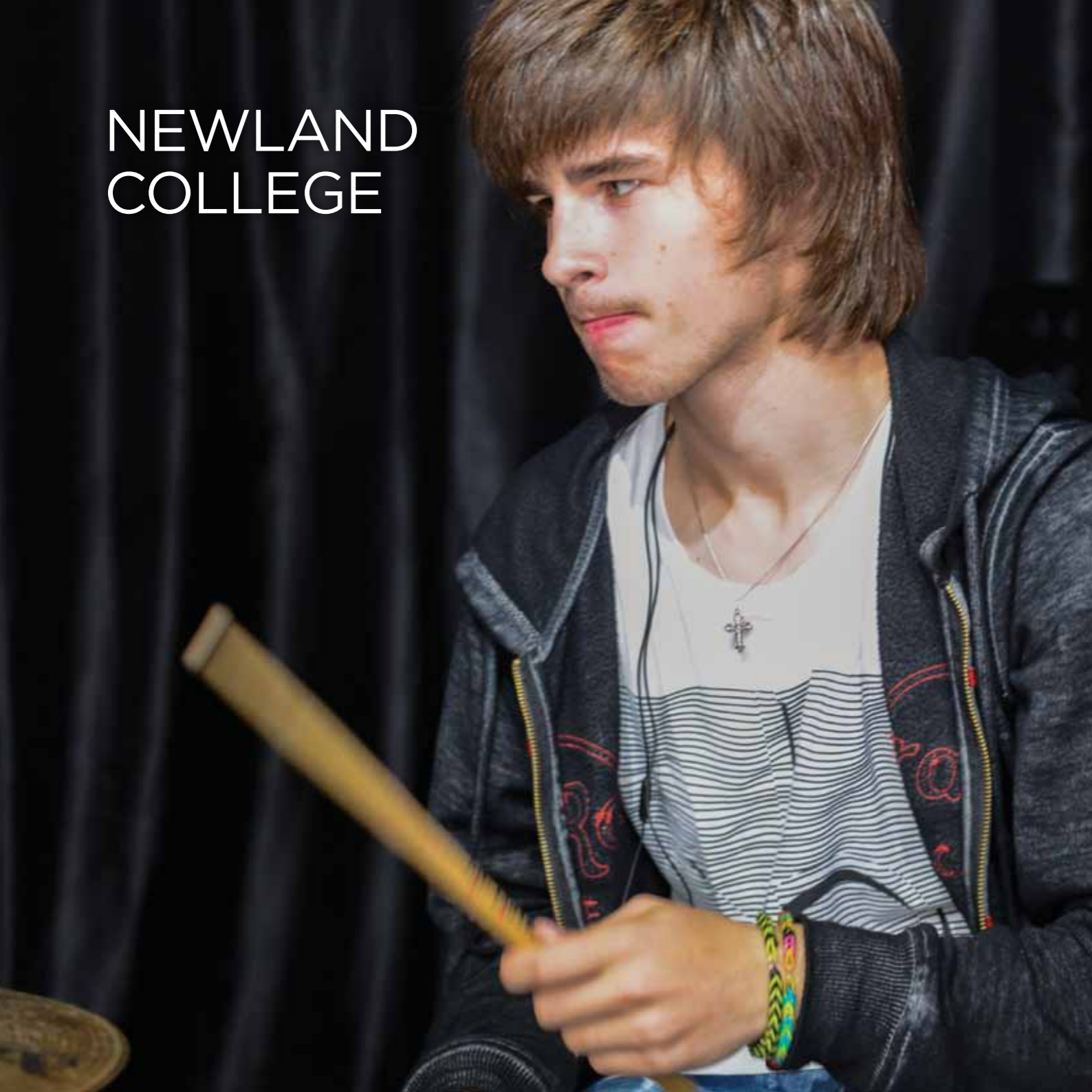
