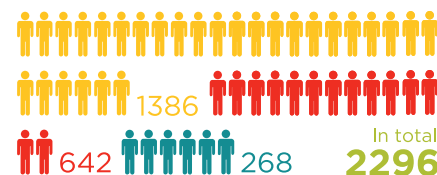

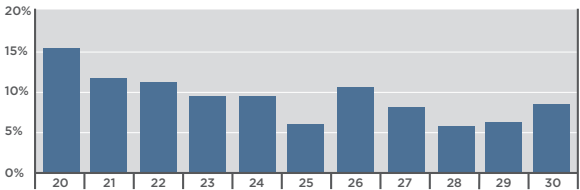

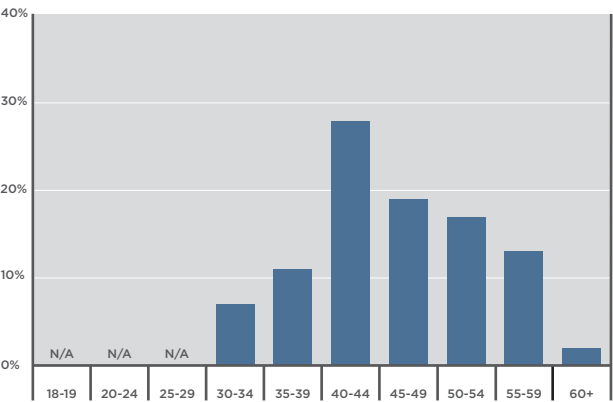

Age profile of participants on all **Westcroft Square** courses. (Average age **29**).

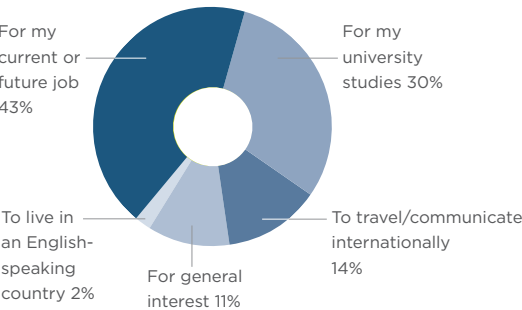


Age profile of participants on our General English 30+ course in **Canterbury** (Average age **46**).
