Exam Preparation

You may need to achieve an IELTS score to attend the university of your choice or want a Cambridge Assessment certificate to help you **progress to the next level in your career.**

An IELTS result is useful if you intend to study at an English speaking university because it is widely recognised by UK, Australian and Canadian university admissions centres as the best way to ensure you have a sufficient level of English for your further studies. It is also recognised by the UK Border Agency as a SELT (Secure English Language Test) for visa purposes.



The Cambridge B2 First Certificate (FCE) is one of the best known English language exams and is suitable for you if you have already reached or have almost reached a B2 (Upper Intermediate) level of English. This qualification is useful to prove to employers and educational authorities that you have a very good level of written and spoken English.

Cambridge C1 Advanced (CAE) is ideal if you are at C1 (Advanced) level or higher and need to show that you can communicate effectively in professional situations or in higher education. It is widely recognised as an entry requirement for over 6000 universities and top companies.



The International Foundation Programme is aimed at international students seeking to study an undergraduate degree at the University of Suffolk. This programme is a collaborative partnership between the Global Banking School (GBS) and the University of Suffolk and is your route to an undergraduate degree at one of the UK's most transformational universities.

We offer maximum flexibility depending on your English ability, you can either join the Extended Foundation Programme (which includes Pre-Sessional English) starting in September, or the standard Foundation Programme starting in January. The Extended Foundation Programme includes a 10-week intensive English Language programme designed to help you improve your English Language skills.

Extended Foundation Programme - Pre-sessional English Programme

The Pre-Sessional English Programme has been designed by the Academic teams at GBS and English Path to develop your English language skills. You will need an IELTS score of 4.5 or equivalent, with a minimum of 4.0 in each component. This is a full-time course delivered over 10 weeks with the aim of enhancing your English language skills to the standard required (IELTS 5.0) for study on one of the pathways of the International Foundation Programme.

It is recommended that you take the Extended Foundation Programme which includes Pre-Sessional English to strengthen your English language skills, even if you are thinking of starting directly onto one of the three pathways of the International Foundation Programme. Taking this English programme will ensure you are able to smoothly progress to an undergraduate degree at the University of Suffolk.

The academic English language content covers four key areas: English grammar and vocabulary, reading, writing, and speaking and listening. Throughout the 10 weeks you will receive regular feedback on your progress with each area through tutor-led feedback, peer review and self-assessment. You will find the programme stimulating since it utilises a variety of teaching methods, including tutor-led classes, seminars, writing workshops, presentations, peer-working, online learning and individual tutorials

Progressing to an Honours Degree

Upon successful completion of your Foundation Programme, and provided you meet the relevant English Language requirements, you will be able to progress onto a University of Suffolk undergraduate degree programme relevant to your chosen pathway (Business and Management, Life Sciences or Digital Technologies). Life Sciences

The Life Sciences Pathway has been designed to provide you with a foundation in biology, biochemistry and physics, and anatomy and physiology. Together with academic study and English language skills provided by the programme this will allow you to progress to one of four named undergraduate degrees at the University of Suffolk.

The Life Sciences Pathway will allow you to choose to progress to one of the following undergraduate degrees:

- BSc (Hons) Biological Sciences
- · BSc (Hons) Biomedical Science
- · BSc (Hons) Nutrition and Human Health
- BSc (Hons) Wildlife, Ecology and Conservation Science

You will study six 20 credit modules, three of which will provide you with essential academic study and writing skills, develop your career aspirations and employability, and academic English skills, and three modules concerned with life sciences topics.

The six modules you will study are as follows:

Functional Skills test Level 2

A popular exam to take at the end of your course could be the Functional Skills test Level 2. 




