

Our Executive Business English Program is designed for professionals who need to learn English for business purposes and who have limited time to study. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

CORE CLASS

Our Core Class is the foundation of our English Language Program and is offered in 18 levels, from beginner to proficient. Students who complete Level 14 are eligible for transfer to many partner colleges and universities. Each level lasts 4 weeks and includes 60 hours of instruction.

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
