IH Hollywood is conveniently located on the iconic “Walk of Fame” close to museums, theatres, and many more area attractions that have become global landmarks.

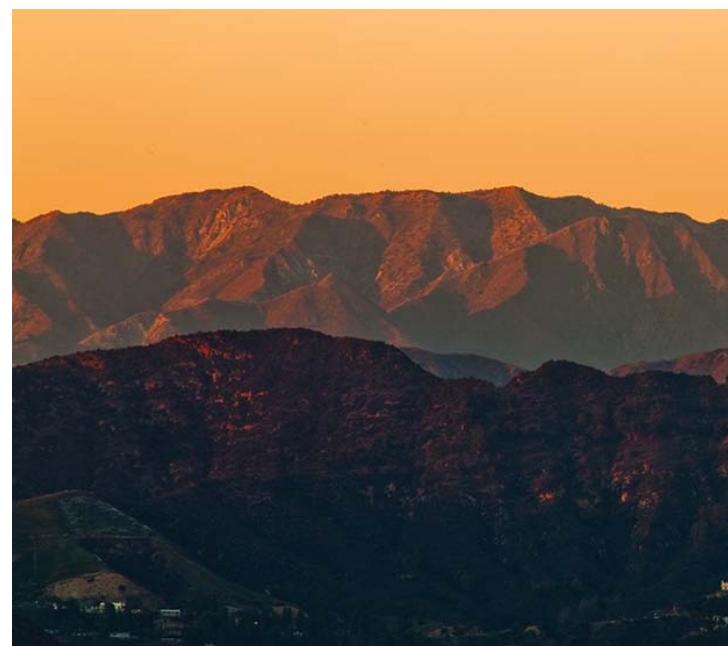

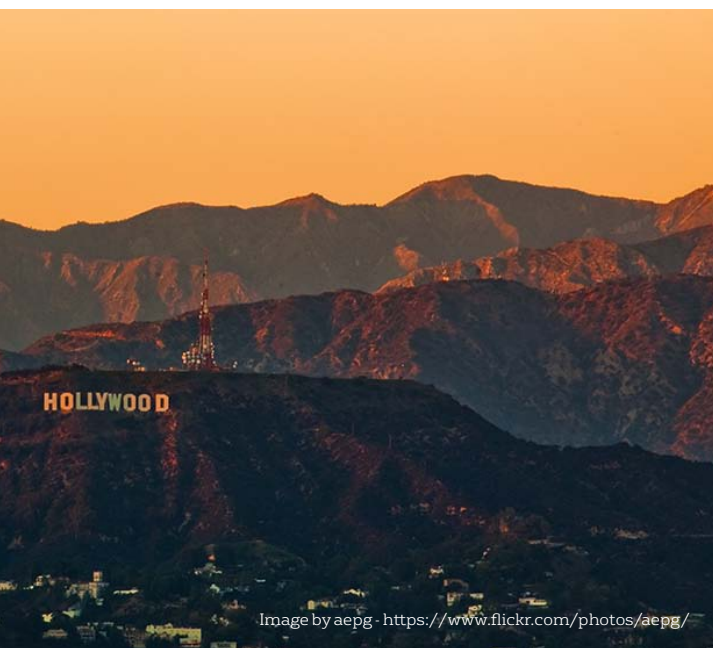

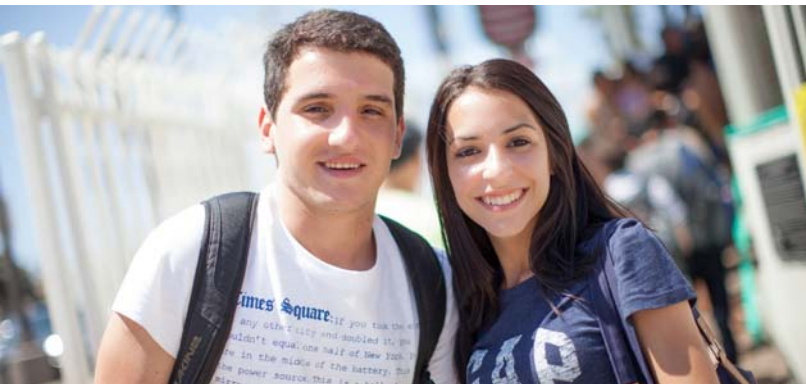
