



Learning Spanish in Seville goes further beyond the walls of your classroom.




Ceramic painting is the heart and soul of the barrio de Triana, where you can learn to feel like a Spanish artist.


A week at CLIC Cadiz






A week at CLIC Málaga

Lets travel to Cordoba, including a walk around the city center, the Jewish quarter, the Roman temple and a visit to the amazing Mezquita.










