ALL ABOUT MALTA

Malta is an island in the centre of the Mediterranean, 100 km south of Italy, enjoying sunny weather practically all the year round. The skies are invariably blue and the sea is warm even in winter, which has made Malta popular with all. It is the ideal place for scuba diving, skiing, swimming, sailing, windsurfing and water polo. Most sports facilities are available on the island including golf, tennis and horse-riding. The English Language Academy (ELA) is located in the popular holiday resort and residential area of Sliema, and is close to St. Julian's, Ta' Xbiex and Valletta. Malta and its smaller sister island, Gozo, are rich in history. There are many prehistoric temples on the island and the oldest surviving free standing man-made temples. The Auberges and the formidable fortifications of the Knights of St. John are still in a remarkable state of preservation. Valletta, the capital of Malta, and Mdina, the capital city before the coming of the Knights of Saint John, boast many art galleries and museums. The Cathedral of the Knights of St. John, in Valletta, is unique for its architecture, paintings and its pavement covered with the coats of arms of the most illustrious families of Europe. Amongst the many treasures in the cathedral, one can find Caravaggio's "St. Jerome" and his only signed masterpiece "The Beheading of St. John".

The Manoel Theatre, in all its Baroque finery is one of Europe's oldest theatres. In spite of its size, Malta is a modern country teeming with life, commerce and industry. In summer, particularly, there is an air of festivity throughout the whole island - the seaside is dotted with the fire of a thousand barbecues, and every weekend there are feasts in different towns and villages in a blaze of colour and with incomparable firework displays. With over 160 years under British rule, Malta is the most British place in Europe and the Mediterranean. Newsagents sell daily English newspapers. Students coming to Malta have every opportunity to practise their English since the language is widely spoken.









EVERYDAY ENGLISH 10 (E10)

A general course aimed at students who would like to improve their communication skills in English. The course focuses on all 4 skill areas of the language, together with grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation. Our trained teachers make use of a number of relevant conversation topics in order to facilitate students' learning.

- Course availability: April to October
- Number of sessions: 10*, 20, 30 or 40 sessions a week (1 session = 45 minutes)
- Maximum number of students: 10
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- 6 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Advanced (C1)

PERSONALISED GENERAL ENGLISH (PE)

This is a tailor-made one-to-one course giving individual attention to participants who would like the fastest possible route to improving their English skills. The student and course tutor together decide which areas to cover, thus maximizing the time at the student's disposition.

- Course availability: All year round
- Number of sessions: 10*, 15, 20, 30 or 40 sessions a week
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- 6 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Advanced (C1)

EVERYDAY ENGLISH 8 (E8)

Similar to Everyday English 10, but offered over the shoulder months (November to March). The emphasis here is still on improving the students' general English usage but with the added benefit of a smaller class.

- Course availability: November to March
- Number of sessions: 10*, 20, 30 or 40 sessions a week (1 session = 45 minutes)
- Maximum number of students: 8
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- 6 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Advanced (C1)

GENERAL ENGLISH COMBI (COMBI)

The Combi course is a combination of the above-mentioned courses. This would be ideal for those students who would want to socialise with other students in a classroom setting but at the same time benefit from the individual attention afforded by a one-to-one course. Students may choose to have individual morning lessons and group lessons in the afternoon or vice versa.

- Course availability: All year round
- Number of sessions: 30 or 40 sessions a week - various combinations possible
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- 6 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Advanced (C1)

* 10 session courses are only available in the afternoon.



TOEFL iBT PREPARATION COURSE (TOEFL)

THE ONLY TOEFL IBT CENTRE IN MALTA

ELA is presently the only certified TOEFL iBT test center in Malta, meaning that our TOEFL iBT students have the added advantage of sitting for their exam on their school premises! This increasingly popular exam is offered on a monthly basis, thus giving students a much needed flexibility which is not so readily available with other examination boards. ELA also boasts of the most comprehensive and up-to-date collection of study material and software on the island, together with tutors specialised in preparing you for this exam. An excellent pass rate in recent years has ensured a constant flow of students to our school to follow this course.

Moreover, our syllabi have recently been updated to reflect the changes brought about in the paper setups of these exams.

BEC AND TOEIC PREPARATION COURSES

BEC and TOEIC are the latest addition to ELA's exam preparation portfolio. Unlike other exams on offer, these are only offered on a one-to-one basis. Up to the time of going to print, our school is the only one in Malta to offer any TOEIC preparation courses.

EXAM COMBI COURSES

The above courses can be combined with our General English courses. These courses consist of 20 lessons General English and 10 afternoon lessons of exam preparation and are aimed at students who would like to focus on their overall General English skills with specific areas of exam preparation courses.

- Total number of sessions: 20 General English sessions and 10 Exam Course sessions
- Minimum course duration: 1 week

- ** 15 session courses are only available for individual courses.



BUSINESS ENGLISH – GROUP (BUS)

These rank amongst the most popular courses at ELA, mainly thanks to our experienced Business English tutors' ability to teach a highly engaging syllabus in a fun communicative way. Topics covered include business correspondence, presentations, business-related vocabulary, CV writing, negotiations and business phoning amongst others.

- Course availability: All year round
- Number of sessions: 10*, 20, 30 and 40 sessions
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- Maximum number of students in a group: 6
- 4 levels offered: from Lower Intermediate (B1 Lower) to Advanced (C1)

BUSINESS COMBI COURSE (BUS COMBI)

An intensive course that combines General English tuition in the morning and Business English in the afternoon. These courses are aimed at those students who would like to maximize on their stay on the islands by combining brushing up their English, together with learning the language in a business context.

- Course availability: All year round
- Total number of sessions: 20 General English sessions and 10 Business Group sessions
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- Maximum number of participants: 10 (AM sessions); 6 (PM sessions)
- 4 levels offered: from Lower Intermediate (B1 Lower) to Advanced (C1)

BUSINESS ENGLISH - EXECUTIVE ONE-TOONE (PSE-BUS)

These executive courses are aimed at the discerning student whose needs go beyond the general business issues covered in the Business English group course. By means of a detailed needs analysis, teacher and student together decide what should be covered during the duration of this course. The student is also encouraged to bring any material he/she may wish to use in order to make the course content more relevant to the student's individual needs.

- Course availability: All year round
- Number of sessions: 10*, 15, 20, 30 and 40 sessions
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- 6 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Advanced (C1)

PERSONALISED SPECIAL ENGLISH (PSE)

Course participants are offered English language practice in a specific field of their choice. ELA would require details of the subject in advance so as to allow us to choose the right tutor for the student in question. Students are also encouraged to bring a selection of their own materials to make the course more relevant to their needs. Subject areas here include: Medicine, Law, Technical, IT, Tourism, Banking, Finance and Engineering. Closed groups may also be organised.

- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- 6 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Advanced (C1)







JUNIOR PROGRAMME

These are tailor-made courses for 4 to 12 yearolds animated by our dedicated teaching staff who combine the three important elements of learning, fun and safety in order to provide exciting lessons in a safe environment. These courses have a totally different syllabus to other adult courses and makes use of various teaching aids to keep our young guests gainfully occupied. Junior courses are run throughout the summer months and are subject to availability during the rest of the year.

- Course availability: June August (subject to availability for the rest of the year)
- Total number of sessions: 20 sessions
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- Maximum number of participants: 12
- 4 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Intermediate (B1 Higher)

SENIOR COURSES

Mature students are bound to benefit from this course which aims to move away from purely academic teaching and instead combine English with Maltese culture, history and traditions. ELA teachers entrusted with these classes are mature themselves and well-versed in these areas. As an option, students may consider combining these courses with ELA's afternoon cultural tours, thus making their stay that bit more complete.

- Course availability: June August
- Total number of sessions: 20
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- Maximum number of participants: 10
- 6 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Advanced (C1)

SUMMER TEEN PROGRAMME

These courses are run for teenagers during the summer months. Emphasis here is on student-centred teaching and participants learn through communicative activities. At ELA we try our best to place teens in class on the basis of proficiency level, different nationalities, age and the right gender balance.


This ensures a high degree of homogeneity which in itself is conducive to learning.

TEACHER TRAINING COURSES (TELT/TEFL CERT.)

These courses are available at various times of the year and interested participants are requested to contact ELA for details. Courses are open to all primary and secondary school teachers of English as a second language in countries where English is considered a foreign language.

* 10 session courses are only available in the afternoon.





GUARDIAN AND CHILD (GC)

This is a newly-introduced course at ELA, ideal for those who would like to have lessons in the company of the children under their care. After conducting a proper needs analysis with the students, teachers prepare two lessons that run simultaneously - one for adults and another for children. The only link between the two is a common theme.

- Course availability: All year round
- Number of sessions: 15, 20 and 30 sessions a week
- Minimum course duration: 1 week
- 6 levels offered: from Beginner (A1) to Advanced (C1) for guardian/s; Beginner (A1) to Intermediate (B1 Higher).

ONE TEACHER TWO STUDENTS

A course aimed for students who would like more individual attention than they would get in a normal group course but at the same time would not like private tuition. This course is ideal for friends or even couples since it can only be booked by two individuals together.

* All the above courses can be followed by an internationally recognised end-of-course exam such as TOEFL Junior and TOEFL itP

BILDUNGSURLAUB: ELA's courses are recognised by the German Bildungsurlaub board. Do not hesitate to contact us for further details


ACCOMMODATION

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GENERAL INFORMATION

COURSES: Classes are run between Mondays & Fridays. The school is closed on public holidays; any sessions missed on these days will be made up for on the other days of the same week. Due to varying travel schedules, alternative arrangements can be made. Students' level of proficiency is established through a written assessment test and an informal oral test on the first day of school. Tests can be sent for (and are also available on our website) and completed before the commencement of the course. All students who attend a minimum of 80% of the course are entitled to a certificate of attendance. Each session is of 45 minutes.

SPECIAL & EXAMINATION COURSES: For students opting to take specialised courses in specific areas (e.g. English for Medical purposes or Legal English; Banking and Accounting, Cambridge First Certificate, etc) at least 1 week advance notice is required to arrange availability of adequate lecturers. Students are encouraged to bring their own textbooks and material for these specialised courses. Kindly note that no examination registration fees are included in our prices and students intending to register for any examination should do so as early as possible. We can assist with the registration at no extra charge.

INDIVIDUAL TUITION

Classes need not be held in the classroom. Alternative arrangements can be made through our administrative office.

COURSE MATERIAL & REGISTRATION FEE: The school provides basic course material at a nominal charge of €20.00 and a course registration fee of €20.00 applies.

TRANSFER RATE: Transfer from Malta International Airport to accommodation, €40.00 return maximum 2 persons. For one way transfer €23.00 for a maximum 2 persons.

ACCOMMODATION: All accommodation is located within walking distance of the school, or on the main bus route.

ACTIVITIES: English Language Academy offers a full programme of activities as well as guided sightseeing tours.

ORGANISED GROUPS: Special rates and arrangements available for organised groups of students travelling together.

LONGER DURATION: Students who book courses of 3 weeks and over, qualify for special rates.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS: Lessons missed on these days will be made up during the rest of the week

BOOKING CONDITIONS: Reservation Procedure: A \in 60.00 non-refundable deposit on the course and a 50% deposit on the total amount of the accommodation if applicable. This should reach ELA at least 2 weeks before the commencement of the course. Balance to be paid on arrival. In the case of late bookings an immediate deposit has to be paid.

CANCELLATION FEES/CHANGE OF COURSE: €20.00 processing fee:

ACCOMMODATION CANCELLATION FEES:

 For cancellations received in writing more than 14 working days before arrival, there is no cancellation fee.
 If accommodation is cancelled less than 15 working days in advance or after arrival, an accommodation cancellation fee may apply. The fee will depend on the contract we have with each individual accommodation provider.

ACCOMMODATION CHANGES: We will charge a €20.00 processing fee in addition to any cancellation fees that may apply. The fee will depend on the contract we have with each individual accommodation provider.

Students who change levels need to pay an additional €10.00 if they want a new workbook

Should a student have any complaints about any aspect of their language stay, this has to be reported IMMEDIATELY to the ELA department concerned. This is mostly done to ensure overall satisfaction of the client. As such, complaints received once the course is finished, unfortunately cannot be considered.

PAYMENT: You can pay us directly by credit card or through a bank. Personal cheques are not accepted. Please allow 10 days for bank transfer. Bank charges (if any) must be paid by the student on arrival.
